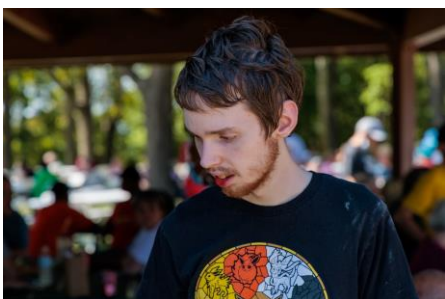

UPDATES FOR FLU CLINICS FOR NORTH AND WEST

We were able to find a provider that will be administering North's flu shots at their on-site flu clinic on Wednesday, October 26th, from 9:00-11:00a. The Visiting Nurse Association (VNA) called us back to let us know they have no minimum number of vaccinations required. Sheila talked with them, and North has set the above date and time for their clinic. After she talked to the VNA, they sent over the forms folks needed to fill out for the flu clinic. This year it's going to be more important than ever to have a flu shot. We'll need a copy of your insurance card(s) attached to the form we've handed out to those signed up. Please be sure and return the form to Sheila before the clinic.

West's on-site flu clinic is still scheduled for Thursday, October 13th, from 9:00-11:00a. There are no changes in time or location. There was a change in who'll be administering the shots. We've had a number of people drop out. I was afraid that we'd have others dropping out as well. The result would have been a last minute cancelation of the clinic. We our original provider and told them that we'd be unable to do the clinic due to not insufficient people and problems in getting paperwork. This decision was a solid one. The Visiting Nurse Association will be doing our flu vaccinations for us as well. They were able to accommodate our already established date of October 13th, and nothing has changed. Thank you to VNA, and we'll see how it goes. Parents and guardians who had already signed up with us to get their shots here, come on and get your shots with us. Before we have the clinic, we'll be in contact to remind those of you signed up of the upcoming date and event. Don't forget – all of you also have to make copies of your insurance cards, and be sure to attach it to the paperwork you'll need to fill out ahead of time, and bring it in. Thanks, everyone, for your patience with the changes and uncertainties. Sometimes it comes out better than it started off.

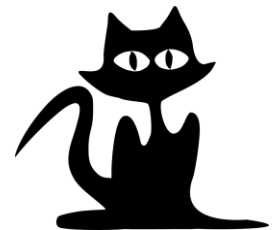

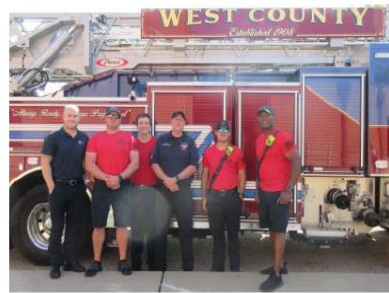
